



## **Scout groups using Bradley Wood during the amber phase of face to face Scouting (COVID-19)**

### **Rules of use**

Scout groups using the site during the Amber phase do so by accepting the rules set out below.

1. Scout groups can only use the site if they have been cleared to deliver face to face scouting using the process set out, that they have a risk assessment for the activities that they will be doing whilst on site and that their leaders are fully up to date with training as per current instruction.
2. Only groups with a booked and confirmed booking will be allowed on site, the site is still closed for any other use during this phase.
3. Groups must use the carpark zone allocated and this must be clearly communicated to parents for drop off AND pick up.
4. Parents will not be allowed to access the site during the period of the group being onsite, if they chose to stay on site, they must remain in their vehicle.
5. Groups must stay for no longer than their 2-hour allocated time.
6. Groups will be allocated a "zone" of the site, they must remain in this zone for the duration of their stay.
7. Groups must travel to and from their car park location to their "zone" as one group.
8. Groups are responsible for bringing their own hand sanitiser with them and this must be used across the whole group upon arrival at the site.
9. Limited toilet facilities will be available, but rules displayed must be carefully followed.
10. Leaders are responsible for recording the names of those visiting during the session so that track and trace can be enabled if required.
11. No on-site activities are available for use or hire, groups must be fully self-sufficient and must bring their own equipment.
12. If groups are having fires, they must use the alter fires provided, fires must remain off ground and the fire must be fully extinguished and cooled before moving the ashes to the bins provided at the skip. Groups wishing to have fires must bring their own shovel and bucket to clear ash / douse fire at end of night. The tap at the rear of the duty wardens flat will be switched on and useable.
13. The group must fully tidy their zone before leaving, all rubbish must be removed from site or disposed of in the large metal bins provided in the top carpark.
14. Leaders are responsible for the care of their young people whilst onsite.
15. Anyone showing symptoms of COVID-19 should not be allowed to visit the site.
